

International Sourcing Exposition for Elevators & Escalators – ISEE 2026

The International Sourcing Exposition for Elevators & Escalators (ISEE) was conceptualized to position **India as a global sourcing** and manufacturing hub for the elevator and escalator industry and as a **strong alternative to China**. Over the years, ISEE has evolved into one of the most significant platforms for the vertical transportation industry, bringing together OEMs, component manufacturers, developers, consultants, architects, and industry professionals from across the world.

The first edition of ISEE was held in December **2022** across 17,000 square metres and witnessed participation from more than 15,000 visitors along with over 150 international and domestic exhibitors. The second edition, held from 5th–7th December **2024** at the Bombay Exhibition Centre, expanded to 25,000 square metres with participation from over 200 exhibitors. The event featured OEMs, parking systems, stairlifts, platform lifts, home lifts, hydraulic lifts, and a wide range of elevator and escalator components, along with showcases of the latest technologies and educational knowledge-sharing sessions.

Building on this growth, the 3rd edition of ISEE India is scheduled from **3–5 December 2026** at **Yashobhoomi (IICC), New Delhi**, and will span across **40,000** sqm of exhibition space, making it the **world's fourth-largest exhibition** dedicated to the elevator and escalator industry. The exhibition will serve as a strategic platform for global buyers and stakeholders to explore India's growing manufacturing capabilities, innovation, engineering expertise, and cost-effective sourcing opportunities.

Aligned with the vision of the Government of India's **"Make in India"** initiative, ISEE aims to strengthen India's position as a preferred global sourcing destination while contributing to economic growth, industrial development, exports, MSME participation, and employment generation. The platform creates opportunities for international collaborations, business networking, technology exchange, and market expansion within the vertical transportation sector.

Beyond the exhibition, ISEE actively promotes industry knowledge-sharing and professional development through **workshops** on the latest **Indian Standards and industry regulations**, **quiz competitions** to encourage awareness of IS 17900 Part 1 & 2, and technical **symposiums** featuring presentations by industry experts. These initiatives create a strong ecosystem for innovation, safety awareness, engineering advancements, and professional exchange within the elevator and escalator industry.
